

RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC

of 17 January 2024 No 49

to restart the implementation of DNSSEC and IPv6 in public administration

Government

I. takes note of the information on the restart of the implementation of DNSSEC and IPv6 technology in the public administration, contained in Part III of document No 25/24;

II. orders

- members of the Government and heads of other central government bodies who have not yet ensured compliance with Government Resolution No 982 of 18 December 2013 on the Report on the implementation of DNSSEC technology and Government Resolution No 727 of 8 June 2009 on the Report on the transition to Internet Protocol version 6 (IPv6), to remedy this situation by 31 December 2024 at the latest,
- 2. members of government and heads of other central government bodies to cease providing government services on IPv4 from 6 June 2032,
- 3. the Minister for Industry and Trade
- a) provide the Government with a monitoring report on the deployment of DNSSEC and IPv6 by 30 June 2025,
- b) evaluate the status of compliance with the conditions for the full transition to IPv6 annually by 30 June and publish this evaluation on the website of the Ministry of Industry and Trade,
- c) report to the Government on the status of preparations for the full transition to IPv6 by 31 May 2027.
